Rasa Heyda, MD joined our Triple Board Residency in June of 2008. She completed her undergraduate studies at the University of California Los Angeles and Duke University. Rasa was Phi Beta Kappa at Duke and later was awarded an NIH Roadmap Fellowship to work in Duke's Brain Imaging and Analysis Center. She dedicated her life to working with children faced with challenges. She worked as a 4th grade school teacher in a self-contained classroom in urban Los Angeles; she moonlighted as a music teacher during medical school at Duke teaching Indian songs and dance; and finally as an exemplary Triple Board resident at Brown Medical School improving the lives of children in need. Rasa continued to shine as soon as she entered the TB program. She used her experience as a teacher to an advantage. She was always well-prepared and demonstrated excellent clinical skills particularly in structuring therapy sessions, collaboratively designing interventions and gently challenging her patients. Rasa was a wonderfully caring, thoughtful, and gentle doctor. She always wanted to do what was best for all she interacted with. She was thorough and kind with patients and a superb team player. Rasa showed great courage over the last two years as she attempted to continue learning while dealing with the assault from rapidly progressing breast cancer. We were all in awe of her ability to quickly accept what had been dealt to her. We watched her gracefully accept the outcome all while continuing to reach out to colleagues, friends and family. Rasa's legacy in the broader Brown Triple Board community is assured. She is a true role model for all triple boarders of the future to aspire to.
